Mike Burnside, Executive Director, KRS

Mike Burnside became the Executive Director of Kentucky Retirement Systems (KRS) on January 3, 2008, where he is responsible for administering the retirement benefits of state and county employees who are members of the Kentucky Employees Retirement System, the County Employees Retirement System and the State Police Retirement System. KRS staff issue over \$1.5 billion annually in pension and health insurance benefits and manage investments for over \$13 billion in trust funds.

Mike has been with state government since 1996 in several different capacities, including Deputy Secretary of the Cabinet for Health and Family Services, and Deputy Secretary and Secretary of the Finance and Administration Cabinet. He was Vice Chair of the Blue Ribbon Commission on Retirement in 2007, and a member of the Governor's Public Pension Working Group in 2008.

A graduate of the United States Air Force Academy, Mike also holds a Master of Science in Management from Troy State University, Alabama. He served 20 years on active duty in the US Air Force where he was a pilot and flight instructor on several different aircraft. Mike and his wife, Patti, make their home in Georgetown.
